Begins with fresh breeze and fine weather at N. at 8 P.M. Herald island bearing N.W. 35 miles dist. Middle & latter part blowing a gale with snow squalls.

First part blowing a gale with clear weather at N.E. at 5 P.M. it moderated. Middle & latter part light breeze and foggy. two sails in sight.
