Saturday Sept 15th /66

Begins with light breeze and foggy at S.E. gamed with the bark George and Nunivik. Middle & latter part light breeze and foggy E.

No Observation.

Sunday Sept 16th

Begins with fresh breeze and fine weather at E. gamed with the bark President of New Bedford. Middle & latter part light breeze & foggy at N.E. saw one tow head going quick. 4 sails in sight.

No Observation.

Monday Sept 17th

Begins with fresh breeze and fine weather at W. all the boats employed whaling. Middle & latter part strong breeze and foggy. 9 sails in sight. Lat 69..25.

Long 171..56.

Tuesday Sept 18th

Begins with strong breeze and clear weather at W. Loward for whales but did not get any. Middle & latter part light breeze and fine weather S.W. saw plenty of whales. 8 ships in sight.

Lat 69..08 North

Long 173..56 West.

Wednesday Sept 19th

Begins with light breeze and fine weather at S.W. saw plenty of whales loward 3 times but without success. Middle & latter part light breeze and fine weather. the watch employed sending a new tow ar main topsail. 6 sails in sight.

Lat 68..59 North

Long 173..30 West.

Thursday Sept 20th /66

Begins with strong breeze and fine weather at S.W. saw plenty of whales. at 12.44 PM. loward all the boats and struck one got him to the ship at 3.30 PM. Middle part employed cutting. latter part light breeze & clear. 2 sails in sight. Lat 68..59 North

Long 173..30 West.

Friday Sept 21st

Begins with fresh breeze and fine weather at W. commenced boiling at 3 PM. Middle and latter part strong breeze and clear. Loward twice to day for whales but did not get any. 9 sails in sight. gamed with the ship Arnolda. Lat 69..32 North.

Long 174..04 West

Saturday Sept 22nd

Begins with strong breeze and fine weather at N.W.B. the day employed boiling. Middle & latter part strong breeze. saw plenty of whales loward and went on to one and missed him. two ships in sight.

Lat 69..26 North.

Long 173..46 West.

Sunday Sept 23rd

Begins with strong breeze and fine weather at N.W. loward for whales but did not get any. Middle part strong breeze finished boiling at 10 PM. latter part moderated commenced stowing down. 11 sails in sight.
