

Ship at George on St Paul.

Thursday Oct 4th 1866

These 24 hours blowing a gale with heavy snow squalls at NW.

Lat 57.. 46

Long 171.. 12.

Friday Oct 5th

Begins with a gale at NW.

3 sails in sight. Spoke the ship Ocean.

Ship under close reefed main topsail. middle & latter part moderate a little. At 10 o'clock made sail and steered SSE. saw St Pauls island bearing SE. 25 dist.

Lat 57.. 11 North

Long 171.. 12 West.

Saturday Oct 6th

Begins with strong breeze and fine weather at NW. saw a number of Right Whales.

Lowered two boats but did not get any. middle & latter part light breeze. lowered for R Whales.

12 ships in sight. engaged with the Gov. Tramp of New Bedford.

Lat 57.. 00 North.

Sunday Oct 7th

Begins with fresh breeze and fine weather at ENE. lowered for R Whales without success. Spoke the bark Norman and Addison of New Bedford. St Pauls I. bearing E. Otter I bearing SE. St Georges bearing SSE. middle & latter part strong breeze at E. 14 sails in sight.

Lat 57.. 04 North.

Monday Oct 8th

First part blowing a gale with cloudy weather at ENE. 7 sails in sight. middle & latter part moderated a little made sail and steered SSE. the ship Europa in company.

Lat 55.. 38 North.

Long 171.. 04 West.

Ship at George from Arctic Ocean to S. J.

Thursday Oct 9th /66

Begins with strong breeze and cloudy weather at NW. all sail set steering SSE. middle & latter part blowing a gale with heavy snow squalls at NW. three sails in sight. all sail set steering SSE.

Lat 52.. 13 North.

Long 171.. 10 West.

Wednesday Oct 10th

Begins with strong breeze and thick snow squalls at NW. at 2 PM. passed through 12. passage. we are now in the North Pacific Ocean with all sail set steering for the Sandwich Islands. middle & latter part strong breeze and fine weather at NW. all sail set steering SSE. 1 sail in sight.

Lat 48.. 40 North.

Thursday Oct 11th

Begins with moderate breeze and fine weather at NW all sail set steering SSE. middle & latter part light breeze and fine weather at E. sent the fore top gallant yard aloft. the watch employed scraping tongs. 1 sail in sight.

Lat 48.. 20 North.

Friday Oct 12th

Begins with fresh breeze and fine weather at E. all sail set steering SSE. the watch employed scraping tongs. middle & latter part strong breeze at ENE.

Lat 46.. 26 North.

Long 169.. 09 West.
