

Ship St George ran 2 winter bay

Saturday Jan 26th 1867

Four boats out whaling
the Larboard boat got one.

Thursday Feb 7th 1867.

Today Capt Soule and Capt
Green of the Ship Fish Perry came to the
conclusion to make ships for the rest of
the season. The Fish Perry is to have
one hundred barrels to the St George's
kind's fire, that being considered as
compensation for the use of the Fish
Perry Gunner's gun.

Friday Feb 15th

Light land and sea breeze.
the boats out chasing whales. took one
(2nd mate of the Fish Perry) and at sun
down had him to the Fish Perry and
cut in. 4 boats a whaling, all the time.

Saturday Feb 16th

Light land and sea breeze
all the boats out whaling. the 2^d
mates of both ships got whales apiece
at 4 PM got them to the St George.

Monday Feb 18th

All the boats out whaling.
at sundown the mate of the Fish Perry
shot one with his Greener gun. at 11⁰⁰ PM
got him to the Fish Perry.

Coast of California Feb 1867.

Monday Feb 25th 1867.

Moderate land and sea breeze
took two whales onto the Larboard Boat
of the Fish Perry. Greener's gun and one to
the Larboard boat of the St George.

Tuesday Feb 26th

All the boats out whaling.
the shipkeepers employed toiling.

Wednesday Feb 27th

Strong breeze from N to NW.
the boats all out whaling.

Thursday Feb 28th

Moderate breezes at NW the boats
all out whaling saw a great many whales.
The shipkeepers employed cooping Oil.

Friday March 1st 1867

Moderate Land and sea breezes.
The shipkeepers employed cooping Oil. All
the boats out whaling. Dashed from two boats
missed to the worst boat.

Saturday March 2nd

Strong sea breezes. all the boats
out whaling. got one to the Larboard
boat of the Fish Perry with Greener's gun
got him to the Fish Perry and cut in
at 5⁰⁰ PM.
