Wednesday March 13 1867

Strong breeze at N.W.
three boats out whaling, saw very few
whales at 12 M. the boats came aboard
and commenced stowing down.

Thursday 14

Light land breeze and fine
weather. two boats aboard stowing
down. and two out whaling
saw few whales.

Friday 15th

Strong breeze at N.W. two
boats out whaling. the other boats
employed washing ship. Got a
whale to the mast boat of the
fish Perry. got him to the St
George and cut in at 8 P.M.

Saturday 16th

Moderate breeze and fine
weather at N.W. Two boats out whaling
the shipkeepers and two boats crews
employed hoisting. At 8 P.M. the
boats came aboard to get the ship
ready for sea.

Sunday 17th

Light breeze and fine weather
at N.W. At 7 A.M. got under
weigh and steered S.W. in
company with the fish Perry.
saw a steamer bound to
San Francisco.

stowing down. Oil.

and Top Gallant Studding Sails.

steering S.W. by W.
