First part strong breeze
& rainy. Latter part light breeze
and fine weather at WNW all sail
set steering by the wind.
Lat 45.. 02
Long 173.. 13

Thursday May 9th

First part fresh breeze
and fine weather Latter part
strong breeze and foggy at SW
all sail set steering WNW.
Lat 46.. 59 North.
Long 172.. 14 East.

Friday May 10th

First part strong breeze
and rain at SE Latter part
blowing a gale at WNW ship
laying to under close reefed fore
and main topsails and storm
sails
Lat 48.. 27
Long 171.. 58

Strong breeze and clear
weather at WNW. Under short
sail steering by the wind. Employed
picking over the potatoes.

Sunday May 12

First part fresh breeze
and fine weather at WNW.
Latter part strong breeze all sail
set steering through the passage
between Atton & Agatton islands
Lat 52.. 14
Long 171.. 43

Monday May 13

First part light breeze
from SE all sail set steering SE
Latter part strong breeze and cloudy
weather at E all sail steering NW
along the South side of Atton island.
No observation.

Tuesday May 14

First part strong breeze at E
ship under top sails steering NBN.
middle & Latter part fresh breeze
and fine weather at NWN.
all sail set steering by the wind.
Lat 55.. 12 North
Long 170.. 16 East

Wednesday May 15

First part fresh breeze
and fine weather NWN. at 4 PM
tacked ship and steered NE by the
wind the water is full of white
wright whale feed. today. Latter part
light breeze at SE steered by the wind.
Lat 55.. 36.. Long 172.. 20
