Thursday May 16.

First part fresh breeze and fine weather at NW. all sail set steering NNE. Latter part light breeze at N steering by the wind.
No Observation.

Friday May 17.

First part light breeze at NE all sail set steering NNE. Latter part light breeze and fine weather at NE. Steered NNE.
No Observation.

Saturday May 18.

First part light breeze and fine weather at NNE. Steered by the wind. Latter part light breeze at N.
No Observation.

Sunday May 19.

First part light breeze and cloudy at NE. at 3 PM Tacked ship and steered NNE by the wind. Latter part light breeze and fine weather at W all sail set steering NNE.

Monday May 20.

First part fresh breeze and clear weather at WSW all sail set steering NNE. one sail in sight. Latter part light breeze and fine weather at ESE steered by the wind.

Tuesday May 21.

First part light breeze and clear at NE all sail set steering by the wind. Latter part fresh breeze and foggy at NE. at 8 AM Tacked ship and steered to the eastward by the wind. Took Lyman Hoge out of irons and put him in the fore-castle he was formerly a boatster.
No Observations.

Wednesday May 22.

First part strong breeze and cloudy at NE. at 12 PM Tacked ship and steered NNE by the wind. Latter part light breeze and clear at NE. Two ships in sight. saw a few chunks of ice.

Lat 61. 35 North
Long 176. 44 East.

Thursday May 23.

First part fresh breeze and clear at NNE all sail set steering to the eastward by the wind at 4 PM came up to a large body of ice Tacked ship and steered NW by the wind three sails in sight. and land to the westward of Cape Karsin. Latter part light breeze and fine weather from NNE to N. employed beating up along the ice.

Lat 61. 28 North.
Long 177. 57 East.

Friday May 24.

First part light breeze and clear at NE. Steered to the east by the wind at 3 PM. came up to a body of ice Tacked ship and steered NNE. Latter part calm the capes Karsin and St Shaddons in sight 6 sails in sight. Lat 62. 05 Long 178. 24.
