Ship St George in the Arctic Ocean
Sunday June 23.

Begins with fresh breeze
and cloudy weather at S.C. finished
sailing at 3 P.M. and commenced
stowing down. Middle & Latter part
moderate breeze and fine weather. finished
stowing down at 11 A.M. 17 sail in
sight. Lat 68..22.

Long 170..45.

Monday June 24

Begins with light breeze and
fine weather at S. all sail set beating
along the ice. Latter part light breeze
all sail set steering to the Eastward
by the wind. 34 sail in sight but no
whales. Lat 68..04.

Long 169..58.

Tuesday June 25

Begins with strong breeze
and clear weather at N.B.W. gamed
with the ship California and bark
Active & Janus. Latter part light breeze
and fine weather. toward for whales, did
not get any. 41 sail in sight.

Lat 67..46.

Long 169..00.

Wednesday June 26

Begins with fresh breeze
and fine weather at N. toward for
whales without success. spoke the ship
Adeline of New Bedford. Latter part
light air and calm. gamed with the bark
Orion of New Bedford. 44 sails in sight.

Ship St George of New Bedford in the Arctic Ocean
Thursday June 27. 1867.

Begins with a fresh breeze
and cloudy weather at N. all sail set
steering to the westward by the wind.
Latter part strong breeze. saw one towhead
hauled and chased him but without success.
one sail in sight.

Friday June 28

Begins with strong breeze and
foggy at N.B.C. Latter part strong breeze
and clear weather. saw 2 ships spout a
whaling and one cutting.

No Observation.

Saturday June 29.

First part strong breeze
at N.B.C. gamed with the bark
President. toward for whales in
company with the President. Middle &
Latter part moderate breeze and cloudy.
at S.S.W. 10 sails in sight.

Lat 68..06.

Long 171..32.

Sunday June 30

First part light breeze and fine
weather at S.C. middle ^{part} toward for a
whale but without success. Latter part
fresh breeze and cloudy weather. spoke the
Bark Martha of New Bedford. three sail
in sight. No Observation.

Monday July 1st

Begins with strong breeze
and cloudy weather at S.C. all sail set
steering N.B.C. at 2 P.M. came up to
a large body of ice. Tacked ship and
steered S.S.W. by the wind. middle part
foggy. Latter part light breeze and clear all sail
set steering N.W. No Observation.
