

Ship at George in Arctic Ocean August 16th

Monday August 19th 1867.

First part strong breeze and snow squalls at N.W. ship under short sail steering E. spoke the bark Courser latter part light and foggy. spoke the ship Ohio. all sail set steering N.E. by the wind. No Observation.

Tuesday August 20.

First part light and foggy at N.W. gamed with bark Seine of New Bedford. middle part blowing strong ship under short sail steering S.E. along the ice latter part moderate breeze and foggy all sail set steering N.E. by the wind.

Lat 69. 46 North.

Wednesday Aug 21. Long 167. 38 West.

First part light breeze and clear weather at N.W. all sail set steering N.E. by the wind. at 6 P.M. tacked ship and steered to the westward by the wind. 3 sail in sight. latter part moderate breeze and cloudy weather. No Observation.

Thursday Aug 22nd.

Begins with a fresh breeze and cloudy weather at N.E. all sail set steering by the wind. 3 sail in sight. latter part fresh breeze with fog & snow ship under short sail steering to the eastward along the ice.

Friday Aug 23. No Observation.

Begins with fresh breeze and foggy at N.W. gamed with the ship Florida & bark James Allen of New Bedford. latter part light breeze and fine weather at S. all sail set steering to the westward by the wind. 2 sail in sight.

Lat 71. 11.

Long 169. 18.

Saturday August 24

Begins with fresh breeze ^{with} fog & snow at S.W. all sail set steering by the wind. at 7 P.M. the wind hauled to N.W. middle part steered N.W. latter part light breeze with heavy snow squalls. saw 5 ships.

Sunday Aug 25.

First part fresh breeze with fog and snow. gamed with the ship Hibernia. at 3 P.M. it cleared up saw 35 ships Herald island in sight bearing N. 5 miles dist. middle part gamed with the ship Winslow of 16 arcs. France and bark Robert Towns of Sydney N.W. latter part strong breeze and clear.

Monday Aug 26

First part blowing strong with snow squalls at N.W. ship under close reefed topsails steering E. spoke the bark Robert Towns. 14 sail in sight. latter part strong breeze and cloudy. bark Robert Towns in company.

Tuesday Aug 27.

First part blowing strong with cloudy weather at N. ship under short sail steering to the eastward. 3 sail in sight. latter part strong breeze and foggy.

Wednesday Aug 28

Begins with a strong breeze and cloudy weather at N.E. 3 sail in sight. ship under short sail steering S.W. middle & latter part strong breeze and clear weather. Lat 70. 51.
