

Sunday September 8.

Begins with a gale at N.E. ship lying to under close reefed main topsails and storm sails. Latter part the wind hauled to E.N.E. and moderated.
Monday Sept 9.

Begins with strong breeze and foggy at E.N.E. set the fore & mizzen topsails and main stay sail. and steered N by the wind. latter part strong with snow & rain. one sail in sight.

Tuesday Sept 10

Begins with moderate breeze clear weather at E.N.E. spoke the bark Eugenia. middle part steered W.B.N. saw Herald island bearing W.B.N. 1 mile distant at 3³⁰ A.M. hauled on the wind to the Eastward. latter part strong breeze and foggy. 3 sail in sight.

Wednesday Sept 11

Begins with strong breeze and foggy at N.N.E. 12 sail in sight spoke the ship George Howland of New Bedford. latter part strong breeze and clear weather at E.N.E. Herald island bearing N.W.B.N. 5 miles dist.

Thursday Sept 12.

Begins with light gales and snow squalls N.N.E. ship under reefed topsails and foresail 20 ships in sight. latter part strong breeze at E.N.E. with a heavy sea. steered to the Northward by the wind.

Friday Sept 13.

Begins with light gales at E.N.E. ship under short sail steering N by the wind. at 6 p.m. the wind hauled to the N.E. wore ship and steered E.S.E. by the wind. latter part moderate breeze steered N by the wind.

Saturday Sept 14.

Begins with moderate breeze and fine weather at N.E. all sail set steering N.W. Herald island in sight bearing W.B.N. 25 miles dist. 6 sail in sight. latter part breeze and clear weather at E.E. all
Lat. 73. 10.

Sunday Sept 15

Begins with light breeze and fine weather at N.E. steered N.W. by the wind. at 2 P.M. came up to a heavy barrier of ice stacked ship and steered E.S.E. hauled with the bark. A tire. 6 sail in sight. latter part fresh breeze with snow squalls all sail set steering S.B.E. by the wind. Herald island bearing S.E. 24 miles dist. discovered a reef extending N.W. from the N.W. Pt. of the island 3 miles in length. at 11 A.M. stacked ship and steered N.E.B.N. Lat 71. 35.

Long 174. 36

Monday Sept 16

Begins with fresh breeze and fine weather at E. all sail set steering by the wind. 5 ships in sight. Herald island bearing S. 5 miles dist. at 6 P.M. latter part light breeze and clear weather at E.N.E. steered S.E. by the wind.

Tuesday Sept 17.

Begins with light breeze and fine weather at N.N.E. all sail set steering E. by the wind. 23 sail in sight. latter part strong breeze and foggy at W.S.W. spoke the ship Adeline.

Wednesday Sept 18.

Begins with moderate breeze and clear weather N.N.W. latter part strong breeze and foggy ship under short sail lying to 5 sail in sight.
