

Thursday Sept 19.

Begins with moderate breeze and clear weather at WNW. 10 sail in sight. latter part light breeze and fine weather.

Lat 70..56 Long 173..53.

Friday Sept 20

Begins with light breeze and fine weather at WSW. gamed with the ship Corinthian of N.B. Middle & latter part light breeze all sail set steering E 1/2 S saw two whales.

Saturday Sept 21st

Begins with light breeze and fine weather at WSW. saw quite a number of whales toward and chased but without success. spoke the ship Corinthian. latter part blowing strong at WNW. saw four whales toward and chased them but very hospice.

Lat 70..25 Long 172..56.

Sunday Sept 22nd

First part strong breeze and fine weather at NW. 12 sail in sight middle & latter part light breeze and fine weather at N. saw quite a number of whales going quick to the NW. spoke bark George of N.B.

Lat 70..30. Long 174..08.

Monday Sept 23rd

Begins with light breeze and fine weather at NNE. saw whales going quick to the NW. latter part light breeze at SE all sail set steering NW. Herald island bearing NW. 35 miles dist.

Tuesday Sept 24th

First part strong breeze and fine weather at SSE. saw plenty of whales toward and chased them but did not get any. latter part strong breeze and clear. Herald island bearing WNW. 25 miles dist.

Wednesday Sept 25

Begins with strong breeze and fine weather at SSE. saw whales toward and struck one got him to the ship at 2³⁰ P.M. hooked on at 3⁴⁵ and finished cutting at 10 P.M. latter part strong breeze. saw a few whales & ships in sight. Herald island bearing WSW. 15 miles dist. Lat 71..23. Long 174..43.

Thursday Sept 26

Begins with moderate breeze and fine weather at SSE. commenced boiling at 8 P.M. latter part light breeze and clear. 10 sail in sight. steered NE by the wind.

Friday Sept 27.

Begins with light breeze and fine weather at SSE. steered to the westward by the wind. employed boiling. saw quite a number of whales. Herald island bearing WSW 15 miles dist. latter part light breeze and clear saw whales toward and ~~spoke~~ got him to the ship at 7³⁰ A.M. at 8³⁰ cooled down and commenced cutting. finished cutting at 12 M.

Saturday Sept 28

Begins with light breeze and fine weather at SSW. saw plenty of whales toward and struck one got him to the ship at 6 P.M. commenced cutting at 7³⁰ finished cutting at 11 P.M. the 4th officer was firing a Bomb Lance at the whale when the gun burst and cut his left hand very bad. he is now off duty being unable to use his arm & hand. latter part strong breeze and clear weather at WSW 5 ships in sight.

Sunday Sept 29

Begins with strong breeze and clear weather at W. saw plenty of whales. all hands employed stowing down oil. commenced boiling at 5 P.M. Herald island bearing WSW 15 miles dist.
