

Ship St George in Behring straits Oct. 1867.
Friday October 11.

Commences with a strong breeze with fog & snow at NW. steered SSE, saw island west of East Cape bearing SW pt 2 at 3⁰⁰ PM. hauled on the wind in company with the bark John P West & Hea Hawaii. Latter part moderate breeze all sail set steering SSE at 11⁰⁰ AM saw East Cape bearing NW 30 S 8 miles dist.

Saturday Oct 12

Begins with fresh breeze and clear weather at NW all sail set steering S. East Cape bearing NW. Dicamedes bearing E 1/2 S 1/2 E. spoke barks John P West & Hea Hawaii. Latter part moderate breeze and fine weather at NE all sail set steering SSW.

Sunday Oct 13

Begins with fresh breeze and rain at NE all sail set steering SSW the barks John P West & Hea Hawaii in company. Latter part light breeze and fine weather at SW all set steering SSE. St Lawrence island in sight bearing NE 10 miles distant.

Monday Oct 14

Commences with light breeze and fine weather at NE all sail set steering SSW. St Lawrence island bearing NE 20 miles distant joined with the John P West. Latter part strong breeze with snow & rain at pt. St Matthews island bearing SE pt 12 o'clock.

Lat 60.28. Long 172.54

Tuesday Oct 15

Commences with strong breeze and cloudy weather at NW. all sail set steering SSE. St Matthews island bearing NE 15 miles dist. employed boiling. Latter part light gales at NW and squally.

Ship St George from Arctic Ocean to Sandwich islands.
Wednesday Oct 10.

Commences with light gales and squally weather at NW ship under easy sail steering SE at 7 o'clock hove to under close reefed topsails John P West in company. Latter part moderate breeze and clear weather at W ship under whole topsails. Jib & foresail steering SE. St Pauls island bearing ESE distant 15 miles.

Thursday Oct 17

Commences with strong breeze and squally weather at SW steered SSE by the wind John P West in company. at 4 PM. the wind hauled to SSW rose ship and steered to the westward. middle part blowing a gale ship under close reefed main topsail. at 2⁰⁰ carried away the foretopmast stay sail. Latter part moderated a little bent up new foretopmast stay sail and set the fore & mizzen topsails. Lat 57.13

Long 170.57.

Friday Oct 18

Commences with light gales at SSW. ship under close reefed topsails and storm sails. heading W. Bark John P West in company. middle & latter part blowing a gale with heavy snow squalls. 2 sail in sight.

Lat 57.30. Long 172.27.

Saturday Oct 19

Commences with light gales and squally at SSW. ship heading to the westward under close reefed topsails and storm sails. Latter part blowing strong and clear weather at WSW. steering SSE in company with the John P West.

Lat 57.03 N Long 172.13 W.

Sunday Oct 20. Commences with strong breeze and heavy snow squalls at W. ship under whole topsails. foresail & jib steering SSE. Latter part strong breeze and fine weather steering SBE under reefed topsails. John P West in company.
