and commenced stowing down.

March 25th

Commenced with light breeze cloudy at
S.W. finished stowing down and washed
ship. Latter part all sail set steering N.E.

March 26th

Begins with light breeze and cloudy weather
at S.W. steered N.E. Middle and Latter
part light breeze and fine weather.
One sail in sight.

March 27th

Commences with light breeze and fine ^{weather}
at S.W. gammed with the Bark Othello of
Hobart Town. Latter part light breeze at S.
all sail set steering to the eastward by the
wind.

March 28th

Commences with strong breeze and cloudy
at S.E. ship under short sail steering S.W. by W.
Latter part fresh and fine weather. One sail in sight.
