

Log of Ship St George of New Bedford
Friday November 10th 1865

Light breezes from E.S.E. and fine weather with occasional squalls, and a heavy swell from S.E. Ship heading to the N.E. by the wind all hands employed fitting butting gear rearing butting falls &c. Lashed the butting pendants with 21 turns of Hemp Rope, 3 inch,

Saturday November 11th 1865

All these 24 hours calm, with a heavy swell from S.E. repaired the upper Foretop sail it having had a hole in it the first day out. the cloth is now tearing at the seams, owing to the Manilla foot Rope being too slack and bad canvas. Sent up the Fore & Main Royal yards and bent the Main Royal all hands on Deck

Sunday November 12th 1865

Commences with a light breeze from S.W. and fine weather all sail set steering E.S.E. the latter part a strong breeze from the same quarter with Rain squalls, one sail in sight

Monday November 13th 1865

Commences with a strong wind from S.W. and cloudy weather all sail set steering S.E. by E. saw a sail to the N.W. the middle a strong wind from W.N.W. heavy squalls of Rain at 1 A.M. took in Topgallant Sails the latter part strong breeze from N.E. by E. all sail set steering S.E. by E. by the wind, ends with Rainy weather

Tuesday November 14th /65

Begins with strong winds from S.E. and rainy weather the middle and latter part a strong gale from S.W. with very heavy squalls of wind & rain, Ship under Lower Main Topsail and reefed Foresail heading to the Eastward

Wednesday November 15th /65

The first part light gales from S.W. with drizzling rain Ship steering E by S. under Topsails the latter part a moderate breeze from West all sail set, all the hands that know the Rigging are having a Watch below those that do not know it are kept on Deck all day

Thursday November 16th /65

Moderate breezes from N.W. and fine weather all sail set steering S.E. by E. the watch employed putting on chafing gear &c

Light airs from N.W. with calms all sail set steering S.E. the watch employed fitting chafing gear making butting stages &c. rove new Lower Main Topsail Braces, 3 inch Rope

Saturday November 18th /65

Light breezes from West and fine weather all sail set steering S.E. by E. set Fore Topmast Studding Sail the watch employed Breaking out water, Breech & Towline
