Sunday November 19th 1865

Light breezes from North
to East all sail set steering S S E. bent & set the
Fore Topmast Studding Sail & Lower Studding sail
Saw a sail steering to the North

Long by Chron 29.50 West

Monday Nov 20th /65

Light breezes from E N E and
fine weather all sail set steering S S E and
the middle part calm the latter part a light
breeze from N N E, saw three sail steering S S W
the Watch employed rattling down the gallant rigging
bitting Onions &c

Long by Chron 29.13 W

Tuesday Nov 21st /65

Commences with a light breeze
from North and fine weather all sail set steering S S E.
the middle calm, the latter part a light air from N W.
the Watch employed serving the Foretop gallant
Back stays in wake of the Dead Eye setting Onions &c

Lat by Obs 29 34 North
Long by Chron 29.12 West

Wednesday Nov 22nd /65

Light breezes from N W. and
fine weather, all sail set steering S by E $\frac{1}{2}$ E
sent the Foretop sail down and cut 12 inches off
the Foot, saw two sail steering to the Southward

Lat by Obs 28.20 N.
Long by Chron 27 48. W

Ship St^r George of New Bedford, bound South
Thursday November 23rd /65

Commences with light
breezes from West and fine weather, all sail set
steering S by E $\frac{1}{2}$ E. the latter part a strong breeze
from N N E, the Watch employed breaking out
Provisions, and Blue Drilling, overhauled each
cask of Slop & Recruits without finding it

Lat by Obs 26.17 North
Long by Acc 27.10 West

Friday Nov 24th /65.

Light air and calms with pass-
ing Showers the Watch employed at various jobs about
the rigging lowered three Boats for grampus with
success, one sail in sight

Lat by Obs 24.47 North
Long by Chron 26.19 West

Saturday Nov 25th /65

Light air from N N W. and
fine weather all sail set steering S $\frac{1}{2}$ E, the Watch
employed fitting Blubber Tackles, overhauling
Spades, making Spade Box, and in making
Whaling Signals used 11 cotton handkerchiefs
out of the Slop Cask, for Boats Waifs

Lat by Obs 23.34 North
Long by Chron 26.07 West

Sunday Nov 26th /65

Begins with light breezes from
North and fine weather all sail set steering S $\frac{1}{2}$ E. the latter
part a strong breeze from N E. with passing Showers
