Thursday Nov 8<sup>th</sup> /66

Light N.E. trades, employed shipping oil. Shipped the last at 11 A.M. whole amount 19891 gallons, Nineteen Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety one gallons, through the afternoon waiting for the Harbor-Master

Light N.E. trades and fine weather employed mooring Ship and breaking out Shocks trimming Ship by the Stern
