

Ship St George of New Bedford at St Quintens Bay coast of California
Thursday Jan 10th /67

Light airs and calms 4 Boats Whaling
took up the Anchor that we had by the Whale and gave him
up

Friday Jan 11th /67

Begins with light winds from S.E. with
fine rain the middle strong from S.W. with heavy rain
the Boats went outside at daylight but returned at
9 o'clock all hands wet through

Saturday Jan 12th /67

The first part moderate winds
from N.W. with light rain. the middle cloudy without
rain 4 Boats out Whaling. the latter part rainy.
at dark, a small Schooner Beating up the Lagoon.

Sunday Jan 13th /67

The first part a light breeze from
N.W. with rain the middle part strong winds from
N.N.W. and clear rugged weather 4 Boats outside chasing
Whales

Monday Jan 14th /67

Light Land and strong Sea Breezes
4 Boats out Whaling. saw plenty of Whales but very shy

Tuesday Jan 15th /67

Land and Sea Breezes. 4 Boats
out chasing Whales. Struck and killed one to the
Ward Boat, and after we had towed him 4 hours
the lines that we had holding him up. parted and
he sunk in 15 fathom of Water

Wednesday Jan 16th /67

Light airs and calms 4 Boats out Whaling
at sundown we tried to haul the Whale up, but parted
from him, very few Whales seen to day,

Thursday Jan 17th /67

Light land and sea breezes
4 Boats out chasing Whales. saw a large number but they
were very shy The 2nd Mate unable to go in his Boat
on account of a sore hand

Friday Jan 18th /67

Light Land and sea breezes
4 Boats off Whaling picked up the Whale that we
killed on the 15th took him to the ship and cut him in

Saturday Jan 19th /67

Light Land and sea breezes
4 Boats off Whaling. the Shipkeepers employed Boating

Sunday Jan 20th /67

A fresh breeze from N.N.W. and
cloudy weather. 4 Boats off Whaling. saw plenty of
Whales but very shy.

Monday Jan 21st /67

Strong winds from N.N.W. and
rugged weather. the Boats all on board. Employed
Coopering and stowing Oil between Decks

Tuesday Jan 22nd /67

Light airs from S.W. with calms
4 Boats off chasing Whales. saw very few, and they were
going quick, and very shy
