

Ship St George of New Bedford & Jereh Perry. Do. Mated.  
Friday March 1<sup>st</sup> /67

Moderate N.W. winds and fine weather  
all the Boats out Whaling. Struck and drewed to the  
Starboard Boat, and missed one to the Waist Boat  
the Shipkeepers employed Coopering Oil

Saturday March 2<sup>nd</sup> /67

Strong breezes from N.W.  
and clear weather. the Mate of the Jereh Perry shot  
a Whale with his Greners Gun. he sunk in 10 fathoms  
of Water with only one line fast to him. Struck  
him again while on the Bottom. with an Iron  
on a 20 foot pole and a bundle of Hoop attached  
to the lower end of it. at 3 P.M. got him to the ship

Sunday March 3<sup>rd</sup> /67

The first part a moderate breeze  
from N.W. with thick fog. the latter part strong from  
N.W. and rugged weather. saw but few Whales

Monday March 4<sup>th</sup> /67

Strong Winds from N.W. and  
clear weather took a Whale to the Waist Boat of the  
Jereh Perry missed another with the Greners Gun

Tuesday March 5<sup>th</sup> /67

Strong N.W. winds and rugged  
weather. 7 Boats out chasing Whales. the 4 Mate of the  
Jereh Perry on board helping to cut.  
Saw but few Whales, and those we did see were  
going quick

Ship St George and Jereh Perry. Mated at St. Quintens Bay. Mar /67  
Wednesday March 6<sup>th</sup> /67

Light Land and strong sea breezes  
all the Boats out chasing Whales. Mason. had  
a good chance to strike a Whale. he was told to dart  
by the Boat head and did not do it. this is the third  
time that he has been within short striking distance  
of a Whale, and each time has failed to dart at them  
he steers the Starboard Boat

Thursday March 7<sup>th</sup> /67

Light land and strong sea breezes  
the Captain disrated Mason. who missed  
the Whale yesterday and turned him forward  
took Smith one of the foremast hands in his  
place. Took two Whales to day, one to the Waist  
Boat and one to the Starboard Boat of the Jereh Perry

Friday March 8<sup>th</sup> /67

Light land and sea breezes  
4 Boats from the St George out, and three from the  
Jereh Perry. took a Devilfish to the Starboard Boat of  
the Jereh Perry, and a Humpback to the Waist Boat  
of the St George. cut in one Devilfish this morning

Saturday March 9<sup>th</sup> /67

Light air from S.E. and fine weather  
cut one Whale. Struck one Whale to the Starboard Boat, and  
killed another. saved both, and got them to the ship before  
before Sunclown
