Sunday November 3rd

Commenced fine am moderate breeze from S ship heading ESE under double reef 4 PM finished washing down set all sail 6,30 PM Wind veered to S by S tacked ship to S by S Middle light breeze from SE Steering SSW by the Wind latter part the same 3 ships in sight Steering to Southward 3 men of duty sick ship leaking 1500 strokes in twenty four hours

Monday November 4th

Commenced fine with light air from SE ship heading SSW all sail set Middle part calm latter part breeze from N steering S by W all sail set 3 men off duty sick ship leaking 1400 stroke in twenty four hours Employed cleaning out between decks one ship in sight

Tuesday November 5th

Commenced fine moderate breeze from N steering S by W all sail set Middle part the same latter part Wind SE with passing squalls steering S by W Employed cleaning ship outside Cooper setting up shooks 3 men off duty sick ship leaking 1200 strokes in twenty four hours 2 ships in sight

Wednesday November 6th

Commenced cloudy with moderate breeze from NNE steering S by W all sail set 7 PM steering N SSW Middle part cloudy 2 AM strove light sails and Luffed & with head yards aback on the starboard tack Latter part 5,30 AM bore up steering SSW set all sail 7 AM saw the West end of Molekai bearing S by W distant 10 miles 8 AM saw the Islands of Nahu bearing S by W distant 20 miles steering S by W 11 AM luffed & off the Harbor of Honolulu 12 AM Capt sent list on shore

Thursday November 7th

Commenced fine moderate breeze from NNE ship off and on the harbor of Honolulu waiting for a pilot 1 PM Pilot came on board 2 PM the tug took us in tow at 3 PM came to with the port anchor and bared away 45 fathoms in the Harbor of Honolulu Latter part Employed drying box and cleaning ship outside the mast of the Cruisers on shore
