N E The Men all on shore fore a run

Monday Nov 11<sup>th</sup>

Commenced fine and  
light breeze from N E next on Wind varied  
to N with rain squalls Employed trying  
to dry and bundle some but had to give up  
several of the Crusers off to day

Tuesday November 12

Commenced fine Weather  
Employed drying and bundling some 4 P M  
finished bundling and delivered on board  
the barge A of Rope 166 Packages containing  
18753 lbs

Wednesday November 13<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with fine  
Weather and light breeze from S E 7 A M  
the Harbour Master came on board to  
hall the ship alongside of the ship  
Roman to discharge Oil 7:30 A M  
hove up and halled alongside commenced  
breaking out Oil Hide of duty sick  
all the Crusers discharged to day
