

Ship St George of New Bedford on a Cruise Feb 18

Friday February 14th Continued
Tatter set on
set all sail steering N⁷ E
saw the Island of Sipan bearing
N⁷ E distant 20 miles 7 A M
Hent the Chains and got the
Anchors of the bow 11:30 A M
Came to off the town of Sipan
with the port Anchor in 13 fathoms
and heered away 50 fathoms of
Chain

Saturday Feb 15th
Commenced fine
Moderate breeze from N⁷ E lying
at Anchor off Sipan Employed
getting of Wood Middle and latter
part rainy Employed getting off
Wood

Sunday Feb 16th
Commenced raining
With fresh breeze from N⁷ E Employed
getting off Wood Middle and
latter part blowing fresh from
N⁷ E with rain squalls

Monday Feb 17th
Commenced blowing
fresh from N⁷ E with rain squalls
1:30 P M let go the Starboard Anchor
and veered away 30 fathoms of Chain
Middle and latter part blowing
fresh and clear weather

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Tuesday Feb 18th
Commenced blowing fresh
from N⁷ E and clear weather to
rugged to land Middle and latter
part more moderate Employed getting
of Coconuts & potatoes 12:30 A M
took the Starboard Anchor

Wednesday Feb 19th
Commenced with fresh
breeze from N⁷ E and clear weather
12:30 P M hove shot and made
sail 1:30 P M triped the Anchor and
stood out to sea under topsail, jib
and courses heading N⁷ W Employed
stowing the Anchors and Chains
Middle and latter part fresh
breeze 10 P M double reefed the
topsail 7 A M saw an Island to N⁷ E

Thursday Feb 20th
Commenced with fresh
breeze from N⁷ E with clear weather
Ship heading N⁷ W under double
reefs courses & jib 8 P M stowed
the jib Middle part 11 P M
lets veer the topsail latter
part the same
