

Tuesday March 17th

Commenced with fresh breeze from N E and cloudy weather steering N W by N under close reef 2 P M set the courses jib and double reefed reefed topsails 4 P M struck the reef out of the Main topsail set the fly jib 5 P M saw land bearing N W by N supposed to be Cape bore up to N W by N 7 P M the ship & S with head yards aback middle part set the fore ship to N E set main topsail sail and fly jib 3 A M wind veered to W took topsail sail and fly jib heading S S W 7 A M wind N E an cloudy ship heading N N W latter part the same 10 A M saw the land bearing N W distant 20 miles 11 A M saw Desjels Island bearing N N W distant 40 miles bore up steering N W by N set all sail

Wednesday March 18th

Commenced with moderate breeze from N E steering to the N W around Cape Sagami for the Harbor of Youkahami 10 A M took a Pilot Cape Sagami bearing S E distant 2 miles 2 P M bent the chains and got the anchors of the bow middle and latter part moderate breeze from N working up to the Harbor of Youkahami 11 30 A M came to with the Port anchor in 6 fathoms and veered away 45 fathoms chain

Thursday March 19th

fine weather moderate breeze from N W employed getting ready for water Panul crew Carpenter discharged sick

Friday March 20th

Commenced with fresh breeze from N E with rain

Saturday March 21th

Commenced blowing fresh from N S W and clear weather 4 P M let go the starboard anchor and veered away 15 fathoms

Sunday March 22th

Moderate breeze from N E and Hazy

Monday March 23th

Moderate breeze from N W and clear employed taking water

Tuesday March 24th

Fresh breeze from S W with rain
