lying off and on the ice the land in sight
from S & N^o distant 30 miles 2 P.M. bent
New Main topsail and got Middle and
latter part moderate breeze from S^o steering
to N^o along the ice several ships in sight
10 P.M. fresh breeze from S saw the ice
& N^o took in topgallant sails and hauled
by the wind to W^oS^o

Fat 70 24 1st

Sunday August 2nd

Commenced blowing
fresh from S and Hoagy ship heading
W^oS^o under topsails courses and got
2 P.M. double reefed the topsails and
puled the jib 6 P.M. saw the ice to the
West of us were ship to S^oE^o set jib
& Middle part calm and light rains
latter part light breeze from S^o and Hoagy
ship heading S^oE^o all sail set one ship
in sight

Monday August 3rd

Commenced with moderate
breeze from S^o and Hoagy ship heading S^oE^o
all sail set 4 P.M. spoke the barge
Orville of New Bedford. Middle
part fresh from N^o ship heading S^oS^o
took in light sails double reefed the topsails
latter part 10 P.M. saw the land bearing
S distant 25 miles the wind N^o and Hoagy
were ship to N^oW^o

Commenced with fresh
breeze from W^oS^oW^o with snow ship heading S^o
under double reef and courses 10 P.M. saw the
ice to the N^oW^o wind veered to N^oW^o were ship to
W^oS^oW^o latter part saw several ships to the Westward along
the ice ship lying off and on the ice

Wednesday August 5th

Commenced blowing fresh from N^oW^o
with passing snow squalls ship lying off and on the
ice under close reef Middle and latter part the same

Commenced blowing fresh from N^oW^o
with passing snow squalls ship lying to of the ice under
close reef Middle and latter part the same left
on board ship California several ships in sight

Friday August 7th

Commenced blowing fresh from N^oW^o
with passing snow squalls ship off and on the ice under
close reef 4 P.M. moderate from N^o gained the
barges Helen Snow Oriole Lydia Progress and
ship California all of New Bedford & 3 P.M. bore
up to the S^o along the ice several ships in sight
Middle and latter part the same 6 P.M. set all
sail 10 P.M. bent New upper Main topsail
