Commenced with fresh breeze from S W and Hazy ship heading S S E all sail set 6 P M took in the light sails Middle part 10 P M wind veered to S E with rain now ship to S S W took in all sail to a close reefed main topsails and fore topmast staysail latter part blowing a Gale from S E lying to under close reefed main topsails and fore topmast staysail 10 A M light breeze from S W and Hazy set the fore and Mizzen topsails close reefed one ship in sight
