Montrop first Officer off duty sick

Sunday April 16th

Commenced with light breeze & fine weather at SSW all sail set heading W 6 PM tacked to SE & shortened sail Middle part the same latter part 8 AM tacked to NSW set all sail 4 ships in sight at 12 M tacked SE the prisoners taking care of luncheon a day H. Montrop first Officer off duty
