Friday June 4th
Commenced fine. Employed
getting wood on board & other small jobs
Andrew Fish told the Captain that
he would not go on board so the Capt
had him put on board; He Fish told
me that he would not do any more duty
on board but I thought that he was drunk
so left him for the Capt to settle with.

Saturday June 5th
Commenced with fresh
breeze from S & Cloudy 10 AM Pilot
& Capt & Lady came off here short &
set all sail 11 AM broke ground &
steak out of the Harbor 12 AM the Pilot
left Cape Breton bearing E distant 3 miles

Sunday June 6th
Commenced with fresh
breeze from S steering E all sail set
7 PM Cape Breton bore S distant 20 miles
Employed in stowing the Anchors & Chains
Andrew Fish told the Capt that
he would not do any more duty on
board so the Capt had him put in
Iron's Middle part fine moderate
from S W steering E by S 1/2 S latter
part the same Employed fitting boats
Changed the day to Saturday
