fresh from NNE with rain ship
under whole topsails & courses
steering SE by E 2 PM double
reefed the topsails 6 PM stowed jib
Middle part the same Fatter part
More Moderate set jib upper topside

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Thursday June 10th

Commenced with fresh breeze
from ENE steering SE under whole
topsails & courses 2 PM set fly jib
& Fore & Main topgails 6 PM stowed
Fore topgail Middle & Fatter part
Moderate from NNE with rain steering ESE
all sail set

Friday June 11th

Commenced with light
breeze from NNE with rain steering ESE
all sail set Andrew Cook Steward
Concluded to do his duty so the Capt
had him taking out of him Middle
part Wind ENE with rain Fatter
part Wind ESE tacked to NNE 10 AM
Wind E tacked SSE

Saturday June 12th

Commenced with light
breeze from E ship heading SSE all
sail set 2 PM fresh breeze stowed light
sails & close reefed the topsails 4 PM
furled the jib & spanker Middle part
the same Fatter part Moderate from N
veering to NNE 5 AM set all sail
