all sail set Middle & Latter part the same
6 AM saw the Island of Trinidad bearing N by E
distant 50 miles

Monday August 2nd 1868

Commenced fine & calm
Middle part 10 PM light breeze from SE
steering N by E all sail set, Latter part 6 AM
Wind veered to E Trinidad Island bearing
E by S distant 10 miles saw two ships steering
