

Continued Remarks On Board

Friday Mar 19th Variation 35.00
Commenced with light breezes from the North with all sail set steering to the south. Middle part thick clearing to the south under whole main top sail double fore & Mizzen Top sails at 3 A.M. the wind shifted suddenly to the S.W. Beared up top sail lay up S.E. and S.E. at 5 A.M. Pinguin & Bear sail up on the other board quarters bearing N.W. Latter part thick & rainy saw several right whales leaved several times with out success? Pinguin sail bearing south Dist 15.26

Saturday Mar 20th
Commenced with a light breeze from the S.E. lay up S.W. with thick and rainy weather saw several right whales leaved without success at 6 P.M. Pinguin sail Bear south 15 Miles Dist. at 6 borence sail heading N.W. Middle part fine Latter part fine weather saw a grate number of small whales leaved several times without success at 11 sail struck one to the S.W. and the Iron drew second one sail in sight Pinguin sail bearing S.W. Dist 25.26

Sunday Mar 21st
Commenced with fine weather saw several small right whales leaved but could not get past to them at sunset saw the Bark under take a whale Middle part Latter part light breezes & calm at 6 A.M. made all sail work at S.W. heading to westward & south & eastward saw several porpoises in site Pinguin sail bearing S.W. Dist 20.26

Monday Mar 22nd
Commenced with fine weather & light breezes and calm at 2 P.M. leaved for right whales at 4 P.M. struck one to the S.W. and killed him at 6 got him along side at 7 hooked on and cut him in at midnight finished cutting Latter part thick and rainy with the wind at 11 lay up 6 P.M. at 7 A.M. commenced beating the ends that weather

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Tuesday Mar 23rd Variation 35.50
Commenced with light breezes from the N with rain bearing to the Eastward under short sail at 6 P.M. covered ship to the N.W. at 4 P.M. the fog cleared cleared up saw Pinguin sail bearing S.E. Dist 5 Miles set the Top sails double reefed heading N.W. Middle part clear Latter part thick at 10 A.M. took in the Store & Mizzen Top sails the ends employed in beating

Wednesday Mar 24th
Commenced with light breezes from the N with a thick fog at Middle and Latter parts the rain under short sail at midnight finished beating Latter part stored down the oil so ends this day thick fog

Thursday Mar 25th
Commenced with light breezes from the N with thick foggy weather heading S.W. & W. S.W. & S.E. Middle & Latter parts the same at 6 P.M. finished beating stowing down the oil

Friday Mar 26th
Commenced with a light breeze from S.W. laying up to the S.W. with a thick foggy Middle part the same at 3 A.M. the wind backed to the N.W. and cleared up at 6 A.M. saw Pinguin sail bearing S.E. light of East and saw along the North side of Pinguin sail a boat 10 Miles dist at 11 it bore south Dist 10 Miles saw only 2 whales in chase of 1 whale

Saturday Mar 27th
Commenced with fine weather with a light breeze from the south saw a grate number of right struck one to the N.W. and the Iron strap parted so lost the whale Middle and Latter part fresh breezes from the North at 11 P.M. ran down under the lee of Pinguin sail and sent two boats to sea if we could find any fish or small whales in chase

Sunday Mar 28th
Commenced with fresh breeze at 2 P.M. firing no fish gave it up and coming on board saw whales from the ship waked the boats to them struck one to the N.W. at 4 P.M. got him to the ship hooked on and cut him in at 7 finished cutting and stowed him for the light breezes from S.W. at 11 lay up 6 P.M. saw several porpoises in site
