 Commenced with light breezes from the N.E. Course S. by E. Middle part the same at 10 A.M. bent the Chances at 6 P.M. made the Is. of Juanak bearing S. by E. 4.50 at 7 light of North and ran along the coast. at 11 bent the Chances second running along the West side of the Is. of Juanak

Friday May 7th
 Commenced with light breezes from the N.E. Course South at 6 P.M. hauled up the top gallant sails and hauled up the Courses. Middle part lay off and on at Saddle the Latter part ran down for the Anchorage at Juanak Is. with light & baffling winds to cross

Saturday May 8th
 Commenced with light and baffling winds at 2 P.M. came to in 12 fathoms of water the Coast bearing Middle & Latter part Calm, one both Match on shore to side

Sunday May 9th
 Commenced with calm & pleasant Middle & Latter part the same employed in taking on board peaches and blanching the ships boards

Monday May 10th
 Commenced with calm weather one watch on shore upon the Is. Middle & Latter part the same
