

Continued Remarks on Board 1847

Monday July 19th

Commenced with strong breezes from S.S.W. at 12 M. Spoke the ship Heald of Stonington Capt Barker 12 months out 700 lbs sperm oil at 1 P.M. Kept the Topsails at Middle and latter part much the same so end this day with pole topsails and fly set. Lat by Ch 6.05 South Long by Ch East

Tuesday July 20th

Commenced with strong breezes from South heading S.S.E. at Middle and latter part much the same with all sail out so end this day. Lat by Ch 5.48 South Long by Ch 44.26 East

Wednesday July 21st

Commenced with strong breezes from S.S.E. heading E.S.E. with all sail out Pump ship 600 strokes at Middle and latter part much the same heading E.S.E. so end this day with all sail out Long by Luncer 45.42 East Lat by Ch 5.12 South

Thursday July 22nd

Commenced with fresh breezes from S.S.E. Pump 3.65 strokes this 24 hours at Middle and latter part squally weather sent the fore topmast staisail so end this day with all sail set. Lat by Ch 5.22 South Long by Luncer 46.59 East

Friday July 23rd

Commenced with fresh breezes and pleasant weather heading East with all sail out Pump ship 2.25 strokes this 24 hours Middle and latter part much the same so end this day. Lat by Ch 4.55 South Long by Luncer 49.20 East

Saturday

Commenced with fresh breezes from S.S.E. heading East with all sail out Pump ship 1.51 strokes this 24 hours at Middle and latter part strong breezes so end this day. Lat by Ch 4.08 South Long by Ch 51.13 East

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Sunday July 25th

Commenced with fresh breezes from S.S.E. with all sail out ship leaked 2.50 strokes this 24 hours at Middle and latter part squally weather this day heading East Lat by Ch 3.41 South Long by Ch 52.45 East

Monday July 26th

Commenced with squally weather with all sail out 2.00 strokes this 24 hours at Middle and latter part more moderate so end this day with all sail out. Lat by Ch 3.14 South Long by Ch 52.39 East

Tuesday July 27th

Commenced with fresh breezes from South Pump ship 4.50 strokes at Middle and latter part squally heading E.S.E. with all sail out so end this day. Lat by Ch 3.25 South Long by Ch 56.26 East

Wednesday July 28th

Commenced with squally weather heading E.S.E. with all sail out Pump ship 1.50 strokes at Middle and latter pleasant weather at 12 M tack ship to W.S.W. so end this day. Lat by Ch 3.52 South Long by Ch 56.32 East

Thursday July 29th

Commenced with fine weather heading S.W.W. with all sail out Pump 2.00 strokes at 5 P.M. saw the see she's Island bearing S.W. dist 25 miles at Middle and latter much the same standing in to the land at 10 P.M. came to anchor under the island of Whiston the ship Arab lay in the anchor Capt Brady of these haven 20 months out 700 lbs sperm oil so end this day Laying to anchor
