

Continued Remarks on Board 1847

Thursday August 12

Commenced with fine weather middle and latter part much the same the barometer watch a shore so end this day.

Friday August 13

Commenced with fine weather Capt Simmons arrived from May He. At middle and latter part much the same so end this day getting of coconuts, coconuts nuts.

Saturday August 14

Commenced with fine weather with squalls at middle and latter part much the same getting ready for sea so end this day.

Sunday August 15

Commenced with the same at 4 P.M. some shots the Capt came of with 1 man missing Peter M. Foxer deserted from the boat and has not to be found the Capt returned to the ship and he paroled out Chane a gain the Cooper has allowed this morning to go on shore for a few hours when he came on board he has some shot interceded and has very happy and insolent the Capt order him into Irons But he in some way got them off and through them over board the Capt has then on shore at Sarcourse when he came on board he ordered him into Irons a gain at middle and latter part Pleasant weather at 1 P.M. took the anchor went to see so end this day John Brown off latter sick

Monday August 16

Commenced with fresh breezes from S.E. with all sail out May He in site and below dist 5 miles of at middle and latter part much the same at 8 A.M. took Cooper out off Irons so end this day Sathby Ch 4.33 Long by Ch 51.33 East

Tuesday August 17

Commenced with fresh breezes from S.E. at 6 P.M. shorten sail and stood boats crew watches at middle and latter part much the same saw several finbacks so end this day Sath by Ch 51.36 East

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Wednesday August 18

Commenced with fresh breezes from S.E. at 6 P.M. shorten sail at middle part Squally latter part the same heading S.S.W. with double reef topsails so end this day during the peak man came to duty Sath by Ch 7.50 South Long by Ch 52.43 East

Thursday August 19

Commenced with fresh breezes from S.E. heading S.S.W. with hole topsail on at middle and latter part Squally so end this day Cruising Sath by Ch 9.14 South Long by Ch 51.36 East

Friday August 20

Commenced with Squally weather double reef the topsails at middle and latter part much the same so end this day Cruising Sath by Ch 10.13 South Long by Ch 51.24 East

Saturday August 21

Commenced with Squally weather at 1 P.M. saw Island of the Shore at 5 P.M. came to anchor in 12 fathoms of water sent 2 boats crew Tuller at middle part the same the boats came of with nothing sprung the Rig but Brown sent it in so end this day laying to anchor

Sunday August 22

Commenced with strong breezes from S.E. 2 boats crew a shore & Capt Simmons off at middle and latter part much the same the boats came of with nothing so end this day Lost the lead see lead
