the Islands of Abiham so latter part more inward
so end this day steering West & North latter part N. by E. 97°
Long by Ch 46. 57. East

Thursday August 26th

Commenced with fresh breezes from S. E. steering West & West under short sail. The land in 1st middle & latter part much the same to ~~the~~ end this day. Beating to the Sward pretty much up to sails. Lat 41° 38' South Long 141° 51' East.

Friday, August 27

Commenced with light breeze
from S. E. at 6 P.M. fell the mainsail & mizen
but to the fore beating. At 8 P.M. middle part bore
ship to the S. W. latter part the same - set fore
topsails so end this day. Lat 34° 15' N. Long 114° 44' W.

Saturday Augus th 28

Commenced with fresh breezes
from S.E. steering N.N.W. subtle reef topsails
at middle of latter part much the same we were
this day. Set by 8. 30 South
Long by 44. 43 East

Sunday August th 29

Commenced with fresh breeze
from S. E. steering off with reef topsails
sent out the Flys in boom at 6 P.M. left to the
wind at middle part much the same latter part steered
off at N. under short sail latter hrs 8.07 Leggett
Long by Ch. 12.17 East

Monday August 30th

at 6 P.M. left to the starboard tack at middle part much the same set hol. topsails. Latter part calm steering West so end this day. Lat by Obs. 8. 02 South Long by Obs. 41. 05 East

Tuesday August 31st

At Middle and latter part light breezes from S. E. Steady
W. N. W. so end this day. Satt bz 167. 31 South
Long bz 140. 04 East

Wednesday, Sept 11

Commenced with light breeze from S. E. Oct 6. P.M. Shorten sail h'd to the E. N. E. 1st Miskell & latter part calm. Oct. 7. 1846. M. Sam. Gaurar Bar so end. this day Cruising Sath by Chs 6. 26 South Long by Ch 4000 East

Thursday Sept 2nd

Commenced with light breeze from S. S. E. Staying by the men the starboard tack about 11 middle of latter much the same at 8.00 A.M. saw school of sperm whaler board the boat for them the starboard boat got fast and down & the whaler went quick on the men came on board w end this day no observation Island in sit Penha
