Monday, Dec 20

Commenced with Calm
and Rainy at Middle part Calm at 7 A.M.
Ward anchor to go for up to Marzke to Capt
& Simmons it is his order he is sick
Latter part light breezes and Pleasant
Weather so end this day. With all sail set

Tuesday, Dec 21

Commenced with fresh breezes
from West all hands in sloped working the
Ship up to Marzke at Middle and latter part
much the same going of and Marzke
at 7 A.M. I took the Capt. Mingo & a fool
boat by & went up to the town & when
I got there found that I had not land
so went to the ship so end this day.

breezes from N.W. at 4 P.M. came to anchor
under St Ann in 14 fathoms of water
the Barge Ann Perez, lained to anchor
Capt. Perry Master 26 Month out 600 lbs
