

Continued Remarks on Board
Monday, Dec^r 27

Commenced with fresh breezes from N. N. W. heading of more at middle & latter part much the same at 2 P. M. took ship to the West at 1 P. M. saw a school of large sperm whales at end this day

Tuesday, Dec^r 28

Commenced with fine weather at 12 M. the whales lost to the ship. Staid Boat board the Star Boat and fasten and kill the 4th boat but not fasten to the boat again. 4 hours at 5 P. M. took the whale long did at middle and latter part much the same at 6 P. M. commenced cutting at 1 P. M. finish cutting so end this day. Long by Ch 56.38 East

Wednesday, Dec^r 29

Commenced with fine weather & light winds all hands in flayed cutting up the whale at 3 P. M. took ship to the N. W. with all sail out at middle & latter part much the same so end this day. Rainy. Long by Ch 56.51 East

Thursday, Dec^r 30

Commenced with fine weather at middle and latter part much the same so end this day. Long by Ch 56.16 South

Friday, Dec^r 31

Commenced with fine weather the sea shell island in sight at middle and latter part much the same the land in sight saw a ship cutting in a whale so end this day. No oil ration

Continued Remarks on Board
Saturday, Jan 1 1848

Commenced with light breezes from N. W. at 3 P. M. took the Barque Ann Perry Capt Perry with 40 lbs whales at middle & latter part calm so end this day. Cruising the Ann Perry in sight at 3.55 South. Long by Ch 56.00 East

Sunday, Jan 2

Commenced with light breezes from S. W. at middle & latter part much the same the Ann Perry in sight so end this day. Long by Ch 55.27 South. Long by bar & Chron 55.47 & 55.38 East

Monday, Jan 3

Commenced with fine weather at middle & latter part Rainy so end this day. Cruising. Sent the old mainsail the blue mainsail here out. Long by Ch 55.25 South. Long by bar & Chron 55.98 & 55.27 East

Tuesday, Jan 4

Commenced with light breezes & Rainy at middle & latter part much the same the Barque Ann Perry in sight so end this day. Long by Ch 55.41 South. Long by Ch 56.10 East

Wednesday, Jan 5

Commenced with light breezes from S. W. the S. Drakon in sight at middle & latter part squally so end this day. Cruising. Long by Ch 55.24 South. Long by Ch 55.34 East

Thursday, Jan 6

Commenced with light breezes from N. E. at middle & latter part Rainy the sea shell island in sight commenced stowing down the oil so end this day. No oil ration
