Saturday May [#]13

Commenced with fresh breezes from S. & E. At 6 P.M. fresh backing At Middle & Satter part much the same so ends this day Com Island in sight & all hands in plowed boating

Sunday May [#]14

Commenced with light breezes from S. & E. At 5 P.M. took the barque Mairielson of New Bedford Capt North 14 month out 200 lbs of sperm oil At Middle & Satter part much the same so ends this day Cruising saw 2 sails & the land in sight

Monday May [#]15

Commenced with fresh breezes from S. & E. At 6 P.M. Capt Simmons took a boat, crew & kept a shore on Denis Island to see how the sick man sit along the ship larks of 8 on At Middle & Satter part light breezes from South At 8 A.M. sent on 8 tips to fill with water At 11 A.M. Capt came of with 60 lbs of bread for vegetables so ends this day steering N.E.

Commenced with squally weather At Middle & Satter part thick & raining weather so ends this day No old ration

Saturday May [#]21

Commenced with Rainy weather At Middle & Satter part Pleasant weather At 8 A.M. saw the island of St Joseph on of the Annamant Island so ends this day Cruising

Sunday May [#]22

Commenced with fresh breezes from S. & E. At 6 P.M. took the barque of St Joseph of the Sea water 5 leagues of At Middle part much the same Satter part strong breezes from S. & E. so ends this day the islands in sight
