Friday Oct 11th

South gales SE + squally ruggs SE. reached East E.
Lat 8 38

Saturday Oct 12th

Came in the same under double reefed to top.
Lat 8 14 Long 53 24

Sunday Oct 13th

South gales SE rainy + ruggs by the wind to the East E.
8 40 53 48

Monday Oct 14th

Came in much the same headed to the E. A. under double
reefed top

8 15 54 33

Tuesday Oct 15th

South gales SE + ruggs squalls of rain at 1 1/2 feet off for
sperm whales at 8 took the 3 one alongside SE got washed
a little + got no whales one or two west off spouting blood
