Tuesday Oct 29th

First part light winds S. & light rain squalls latter as
before Sols & one ship in sight

Moderate winds S. & rainy squally weather a ship & bark
in sight No Obs

Wednesday Nov 6th

Light winds N. & light showers of rain at sunset 2 M. E by S. from
the Pierre backed to the S.E. latter wind N.E. bound in to Pres-
ter for water

Thursday Nov 7th

Light winds N.E. at 2 P.M. came to anchor at Boston in 11 1/2 fathoms
water

Friday Nov 8th

Light and a little rain got off 21 pipes & casks water blacked heads
painted water &c.

Saturday Nov 9th

Light winds S.E. & some rain latter part took on board 1700 potatoes
& got under way

Sunday Nov 10

Light and calm land in sight & one sail

Monday Nov 11th

Light and S.W. spoke bark Bonita States 260 bbls

Tuesday Nov 12th

Light winds & rainy 3 sail in sight

Wednesday Nov 13th

Light variable winds & rainy spoke ship from Lee of N. York
9.00 Spinn 200 bbls

Thursday Nov 14th

Weather much the same Dennis Sols in sight bearing S 18 N
spoke bark Merrimack 350 spinn & the Lee mid & latter
bark

Friday Nov 15th Lat 3.18 57 30
