Light and calm from S. E. to S. W. till Thursday & very pleasant

Thursday 23 Oct

First first light and S. W. Mid fine breeze S. W. steered S. E. Latter wind ceased. S. W. with some clouds about the horizon & perhaps a small shower from them

Friday Oct 26

Wind light from N. to N. E. & pleasant many fished about

Saturday Oct 25

Fine breeze from S. E. by the wind S. E. Lat 3 37 54

Sunday Oct 26

Moderate breeze S. E. at 7 o'clock the S. W. saw a black bird to the N. W.

Monday Oct 27

Light breeze S. E. morning to the E. Lat 3 53 54 45

Tuesday Oct 28

Light breeze S. E. & pleasant 2 sail in sight Lat 3 29 55 5

Wednesday Oct 29

First part light breeze S. E. & pleasant Com. S. E. in sight spoke black Com. S. E. 100 lbs the Marcella in sight

Thursday Oct 30

Light breeze S. E. by the wind S. E. at 6 A.M. saw a sperm whale at 10 o'clock saw took him to the ship at 12

Lat 3 30 56

Friday Oct 31st

Light breeze S. E. coming cutting at 6 P.M. finished one sail in sight (at 11 fixed up)

Lat 3 29 56 57

Saturday Nov 1

Fine breeze S. E. by the wind S. W. B. S. W. at 3.56 56 22

Sunday Nov 2

At 24 hours light and S. E. land in sight at 11 P.M. finished

Lat 6 16

Ship St. Peter off the Mayhe Bank

Monday Nov 3. 1857

Light and calm nearly all the day in sight Lat 4 22

Tuesday Nov 4th

Came in with light and many many fished in sight

Wednesday Nov 5th

Light and from N. E. to S. E. and calm B. S. W. by S. 20 ms

Thursday Nov 6th

Light and from S. E. to W. at 8 A.M. came to anchor at B. S. W. & stowed down the oil

Friday Nov 7

Fine weather all hands after noon & water

Saturday Nov 8

One watch after noon the start on liberty

Sunday Nov 9th

Fine weather most of the even on shore

Monday Nov 10th

Fine weather all hands making preparations for sea

Tuesday Nov 11

Light and calm at 8 o'clock under weigh went to League with my boat to ship a man but could find none to go

Wednesday Nov 12

First part showers of rain at 5 returned on board & steered S. E. Latter squalls of rain the land & one sail in sight

Thursday Nov 13th

Fresh breeze & squalls of rain from W. south of the top

Friday Nov 14

Lat 3 25 56 26

First part light breeze from S. E. later light air & calm

Saturday Nov 15

Lat 3 21 56 40

First part light and calm with current to S. E. later light breeze S. E. most of the Mayhe S. E. in sight

Sunday Nov 16

Lat 3 18 56 4

Monday Nov 17

Light and S. E. & S. between Com. S. E. & Dennis S. E.

Tuesday Nov 18

Lat 3 39 55 30

Light southerly mounds & calm land in sight

Wednesday Nov 19th

First part light wind S. & showers of rain Latter fine weather went on shore at Com. S. E. found no eggs but caught a few fresh

Thursday Nov 20

Fine breeze S. W. steering to the E. Dennis S. E. in sight

Friday Nov 21st

Light mounds S. W. by the wind S. Lat 4 25 56 48

Saturday Nov 22

Light mounds S. W. at 6 o'clock to S. W. Lat 3 57

Sund in sight
