

Ship St. Peter off the Mayke Bank

Sunday Nov 23<sup>rd</sup> 1851

Yards breeze W off NE corner of the bank

Monday Nov 24

Yards gales from NW to SW & rising spoke Dashed from Henry of Warren 17 m 170 lbs Clarice at 3 22 270

Tuesday Nov 25

North breeze NW & a strong current ENE. saw Dennis 1st

Wednesday Nov 26<sup>th</sup> 3 28

Light winds NW & pleasant with strong current

Thursday Nov 27 Lat 3 42

All this 26<sup>th</sup> the same most of the flocks in sight

Friday Nov 28 3 49 56.5

Light winds NW & good weather ending NE of the bank

Saturday Nov 29

Light winds & pleasant commenced netting the oil was checked a little

Sunday Nov 30

Light wind NW at 11 AM saw whales breaching Lat 3 12 55 35

Monday Dec 1<sup>st</sup>

Light air & calm put off for the whales killed 3 but the ship being so far from the boats & night coming on lost one of them latter part out in the 2 whales & put off for another school so crews boats still in chase Dennis 1st at 25 m (took the last one 12 at night)

Tuesday Dec 2<sup>nd</sup>

Light wind NW got one whale struck one on two more forepart of the hull. another & finally only saved the one one ship in sight proved to be the brand 850 from 100 m in the eve the (capt came on board & brought a letter from my wife written 26 days after I sailed. 26 m out nearly touched one other monster & after a while was here but I feel thankful for that much. I wish what a great source of pleasure to me here than a few lines penned by her. Latter cut the whale

Wednesday Dec 3<sup>rd</sup>

Light air NW boiling at 5 picked up one of the dead whales but the sharks had eaten half his shoulder

Thursday Dec 4<sup>th</sup>

Light breeze NW & steering to the NE. Calm part rainy flocks boiling the brand in sight. All sail out looking for them

Friday Dec 5<sup>th</sup>

Light winds & fine weather spoke Prash Maria of 17 330 lbs

Saturday Dec 6<sup>th</sup>

Light air SE the No brand & limited states in sight also one of the 1st (saw the whale) Sunday Dec 7<sup>th</sup>

Light wind SE steered NW Dennis 1st & the ship in sight

Monday Dec 8<sup>th</sup> 1851

Light wind & calm current to SE

Tuesday Dec 9<sup>th</sup>

This 26<sup>th</sup> the same two sail in sight also Dennis 1st

Wednesday Dec 10<sup>th</sup>

Light variable and calm the brand in sight also Dennis 1st

Thursday Dec 11<sup>th</sup>

Light 80 lbs spar in after hats this 24 light and calm Dennis 1st in sight

Friday Dec 12<sup>th</sup>

This day the same reported the sail & hunk seen May 1st two sail in sight some clouds passing with a little rain

Saturday Dec 13<sup>th</sup> 3 29

Most of this 26<sup>th</sup> calm with some rain Lat 3 21

Sunday Dec 14<sup>th</sup>

Light air & calm two sail in sight Lat 3 16 56 2

Monday Dec 15<sup>th</sup>

Light breeze from NW to SW with a light shower occasional trying to work to W. against the current Lat 3 32 56 5

Tuesday Dec 16<sup>th</sup>

This 26<sup>th</sup> the same Prash & the Prash Clarice in sight

Wednesday Dec 17<sup>th</sup> 3

Wind from NW to SW with squalls of rain Lat 3 32 36 15

Thursday Dec 18<sup>th</sup>

Continues the same one sail in sight

Friday Dec 19<sup>th</sup>

Yards breeze NW steered NW saw Dennis 1st Lat 3 29 55 20

Saturday Dec 20<sup>th</sup>

Wood boat steered NW

Sunday Dec 21<sup>st</sup>

Light winds NW & fine weather saw 1st in sight and on sail

Monday Dec 22<sup>nd</sup>

Light part from weather spoke Prash Maria of 17 330 lbs 550 from 100 m with rain Lat 3 29

Tuesday Dec 23<sup>rd</sup>

Light winds NW & NW two sail in sight

Wednesday Dec 24<sup>th</sup>

one in the same spoke Prash Maria of 17 330 lbs & the other by the name of Charly at 100 m for month

Thursday Dec 25<sup>th</sup>

Wind NW & NW steered to NW the No in 60

Friday Dec 26<sup>th</sup>

Yards breeze NW by the wind the signals of rain Lat 3 11

Strong current E
