

Mon Aug 18. Keels by (Cordado & Bunker) 1 52 6 bearing 95° S. wind

Mark C. H. Pigeon on a whaling voyage sailed June 12/54

Picked up a stick of Mahogany 25 ft long 15 in square sold it at
Floury for \$8.00

Saw part of the spars rigging & sails of a ship of about 300 tons
the lower mast appeared to be burnt off about half the lower part.
to rugged to save any thing Lat 41 40 N Long 38 15 W

Left Fayal Aug 21st 54. Aug 22 Spoke the Portuguese Brig (Mary) from
Pico de Funchal for Fayal supplied him with a bbl Beef and 145 lbs Bread
same day Spoke Peter. Harvey Capt. Hickey of New Orleans from Lighorn
for Philadelphia with marble & rags sold him 200 lbs Bread

Aug 28 Spoke Ship Northern Lucy of N York 100 bbls Flour Lat 32 30 N Long 23

Van Lipt 3^d Fell in with the side of a schooner apparently new
took from it 2 chain plates about two buckets of bolts & spikes & some
planks Lat 32.3 Long 23.3
