Begin & End with a light westerly breeze &c. &c.

Begin & End with a light S. westerly breeze under all sail &c.

Lat. by Obs. $35^{\circ}10'$ N. Long. by Chr. $43^{\circ}23'$ W.

Thursday 29th.

Begin & End with a light westerly breeze. Sail in sight.

Lat. by Obs. $35^{\circ}28'$ N. Long. by Chr. $43^{\circ}06'$ W.

Friday 30th.

Begin & End with a light westerly breeze. S. part under Obs. Mr. T. Sails courses & fobs.

Lat. by Obs. $35^{\circ}32'$ N. Long. by Chr. $41^{\circ}29'$ W.

Saturday July 1st 1843.

Begin & End with a moderate westerly breeze under all sail. Sails courses & fobs.

Begin with a light westerly breeze under all sail. Sails courses & fobs. Under single Mr. T. Sails.

Monday 3rd.

Begin & End with a light westerly breeze under all sail.

Lat. by Obs. $35^{\circ}41'$ N. Long. by Chr. $38^{\circ}45'$ W.

Tuesday 4th.

Begin & End with a light S. westerly breeze under all sail.

Lat. by Obs. $35^{\circ}42'$ N. Long. by Chr. $39^{\circ}38'$ W.

Wednesday 5th.

Begin & End pleasant with a light S. westerly breeze.

Lat. by Obs. $35^{\circ}44'$ N. Long. by Chr. $39^{\circ}30'$ W.
