Begin with a strong southerly breeze heading S.W.
W. & S. part strong S.W. trade wind steering S.W.
under all sail. Crew employed in picking cotton &c.
saw one tail.
Lat. by Obs. 5° 28' S. Long. by Obs. 27° 15' W.

Wednesday Oct. 1st

Begin & End with a strong S.W. trade breeze steering S.W.
Lat. by Obs. 8° 1' S. Long. by Obs. 29° 21' W.

Thursday 2d

Begin & End pleasant with fresh trade breeze steering
S.W. under all sail.
Lat. by Obs. 8° 24' S. Long. by Obs. 31° 20' W.

S.W. & S. part fresh " " " " & cloudy " "
Lat. by Obs. 12° 00' S. Long. by Obs. 32° 16' W.

Sunday 5th

Begin & End with a fresh S.W. trade breeze.
steering S.W. saw three tails.
Lat. by Obs. 13° 49' S. Long. by Obs. 33° 25' W.

Monday 6th

Begin & End cloudy with a fresh S.W. trade breeze
steering S.W.
Lat. by Obs. 15° 38' S. Long. by Obs. 34° 25' W.
