sail. Mr. part sails L. part sails & C. breeze cruising for
Whales sent down 2nd & 3rd sails Standing Boat Crews watching

Tuesday 8th

Began & ends pleasant with a light southerly breeze
cruising under all sail

Lat by Obs. 16° 54' S. Long. by Chr. 56° 39' W.

Wednesday 9th

Began pleasant with a light southerly breeze. Mr. & L. part
light S.W. breeze. Cruising under all sail.

Lat by Obs. 17° 20' S. Long. by Chr. 56° 54' W.

Thursday 10th

Began pleasant with a light southerly breeze. Mr. part
under all sail. Lat. not light breeze and continued
rain under short sail.

Saturday Nov 11th 1843

Began with a strong southerly breeze under all
sail. Mr. part sails L. part sails & C. breeze cruising
for Whales sent down 2nd & 3rd sails Standing Boat Crews watching
strong breeze & squally under short sail & a few Whales

Lat by Obs. 17° 12' S. Long. by Chr. 57° 29' W.

Sunday Nov 12th

Began with a strong S.W. breeze under short sail
Mr. part the same L. part under all sail & pleasant.

Lat by Obs. 16° 57' S. Long. by Chr. 57° 30' W.

Monday 13th

Began & ends pleasant with a fresh southerly breeze
cruising under all sail. Lat. L. part several Whales.

Lat by Obs. 16° 52' S. Long. by Chr. 57° 37' W.

Tuesday 14th

Began pleasant with a fresh S.W. breeze under all sail
L. part fresh breeze & hawking with some rain took in
Mr. S. S. sails. Lat. L. part several Whales.
