a whale.

Begin Calm. M. part light S. E. breeze heading N. E.
L. part light S. E. breeze Steering N. E. by E. Boat
later sail.

at 10 P. M. saw several Whales lowered S. & E. Boat
& M. Boat got up at 4 a. clock shortened sail & commenced
standing water in boat crews M. part pleasant Steering
N. E. by E. L. part with the breeze Steering N. by E. under
all sail except M. S. sail & M. sail &c.

saw several Louisa of Elizabeth City for West Indies loaded
with lumber, 15 days out saw several sail.

Saturday 25th

Begin pleasant & calm. M. & L. part light breeze
saw several sail & Steamships.

sail.
