Friday June 21st 1844

Begins pleasant with a fresh S.W. breeze lying off & on the side of clouds traded 3 P.M. Breeze for recruits &c. & shipped 3 men Mr. part steering along the East side of Hays under short sail. Latter part fresh breeze steering S.E. under all sail.

Lat. by Obs. $39^{\circ} 01'$ N. Long. by Obs. $30^{\circ} 52'$ W.

Saturday 22nd

Begins smoky & a fresh S.W. breeze steering N.E. by E. Mr. part strong breeze & squally at 12 o'clock luffed to heading to the southward. Latter part strong breeze from the S.E. steering for Terceira under 3 sails & courses. St. George & Matiosa in sight.

Sunday 23rd

Begins with a strong S.E. breeze & squally under 3 sails & courses steering S.W. by S. at 10th P.M. passed by the West end of Terceira saw an English Steamer & a Portuguese man of war. Mr. part lying off & on the South side of Terceira. Latter part spoke Brigg Juno, Spenser N.P. 11 m. out. 12th P.M. heard from Brigg Tyleston Lucc. Nantucket 7 1/2 m. out 5th P.M.

Monday 24th June 1844.

Begins with a strong breeze from the S.W. lying to under the lee of Terceira under short sail. Latter part the same. Latter part fresh breeze cruising in sight of the Whale Rock under all sail. Lat 11 A.M. took in 3 sails saw several sails.

Tuesday 25th

Begins pleasant with a fresh breeze at 3 P.M. squally at 5 P.M. Breeze. Latter part lying to under short sail.

Wednesday 26th

Begins with a strong S.W. breeze lying under short sail. Spoke schooner Brown of Provincetown & m. out 7th P.M. Latter part fresh breeze cruising under all sail.

Thursday 27th

Begins with a strong S.W. breeze cruising off the Whale Rock under 3 sails & courses at 10 o'clock. Latter part heading W. by S. at 12 o'clock set 3 sails & m. 3 sails. Latter part light baffling breeze.

Friday 28th

Begins calm at 4 o'clock light S.W. breeze heading W. by S. at 7 o'clock. Breeze of 30 bearing S. 30 miles distant. Mr. part fine breeze heading W. by S. Latter part pleasant with a light southerly breeze steering W. by S. at 10th P.M. Studding sail.
