Begins & Ends pleasant with a light westerly breeze heading at N. by E. & C. saw one sail. all clear.

Friday 5th

Begins & Ends pleasant with a light westerly breeze heading at N. by E. & C. at 11 A.M. saw British lower- ed Boat but did not get fast.

Saturday 6th

Begins & Ends pleasant with a light S. westerly breeze heading from N. by E. to N. by E. & C. saw several sails.

Sunday 7th
