Monday 29th

Begins with a moderate westerly breeze. M. & L. part light breeze. Cruising under all sail. Saw one seal.

Lat. by Obs. 35° 20' N. Long. by Chr. 46° 17' W.

Tuesday 30th

Begins & ends pleasant with a light southerly breeze. Under all sail. Saw many seals.

Lat. by Obs. 36° 10' N. Long. by Chr. 46° 08' W.

Wednesday July 31st 1844.

Begins & ends pleasant with a light S. Easterly breeze under all sail.

Lat. by Obs. 36° 00' N. Long. by Chr. 45° 50' W.

Thursday Aug. 1st 1844

Begins with a fresh S. Easterly breeze. Cruising under short sails. M. & L. part light breeze. At 9 A.M. saw several sperm whales. Toward 4 P.M. saw a Boat fastened to one.

Friday 2nd

Begins pleasant. Boat fastened to a whale at 2 P.M. had him along side at 3 P.M. Commenced cutting in at 8 finished & commenced boiling M. & L. part crew employed in boiling whale. With pleasant weather & a light breeze.

Saturday 3rd

Begins & ends pleasant with a light S. E. breeze. Crew employed in boiling whale at 11 A.M. finished boiling.
