

Tuesday Aug 13th 1844.

Begin & End pleasant with a fresh S. Westerly breeze under all sail saw the aforementioned Whales until 4 P.M. Still going to windward & three sails.

Lat. by Obs. 35° 49' N. Long. by Chr. 47° 05' W.

Wednesday 14th.

Begin & End pleasant with a fresh S. W. breeze. at 7 A.M. furl'd M. S. sail. saw two sails.

Lat. by Obs. 35° 45' N. Long. by Chr. 46° 35' W.

Thursday 15th.

Begin & End with a fresh S. Westerly breeze under all sail. at 7 Shortened sail as usual. M. & P. part squally & some rain at 10 A.M. under J. sail & J. sail &c. saw 3 or 4.

Lat. by Obs. 35° 32' N. Long. by Chr. 46° 40' W.

Friday 16th.

Begin squally with a fresh Westerly breeze under all sail. M. part squally with rain at 8 A.M. fresh S. E. gale. Chr. M. S. sail & J. sail &c.

Lat. by Obs. 35° 30' N. Long. by Chr. 47° 00' W.

Saturday Aug 17th 1844.

Begin with a fresh gale by day to under Chr. M. S. sail. at 10 A.M. part fresh Westerly breeze at 10 A.M. under J. sail & J. sail &c. saw one sail.

Lat. by Obs. 36° 15' N. Long. by Chr. 48° 15' W.

Sunday 18th.

Begin & End by day with a fresh E. Easterly breeze under J. sail & J. sail &c.

Lat. by Obs. 36° 07' N. Long. by Chr. 47° 47' W.

Monday 19th.

Begin & End by day with a fresh S. Easterly breeze. standing under top sail &c.

Lat. by Obs. 36° 04' N. Long. by Chr. 46° 49' W.

Tuesday 20th.

Begin & End by day with a strong S. Westerly breeze standing under J. sail & J. sail.

Lat. by Obs. 35° 46' N. Long. by Chr. 45° 36' W.
