

Thursday Aug. 29th 1844.

Begins with a fresh southerly breeze under Short Sail.
L. part light, S. part Easterly breeze. under all sail crew
employed in getting rigging &c.

Lat. by Obs. 35° 32' N. Long. by Obs. 44° 10' W.

Friday 30th.

Begins pleasant with a light, northerly breeze. Cruising
under all sail. No part squally. L. part fresh breeze
under short sail sent down S. part & mended it &c.

Lat. by Obs. 36° 04' N. Long. by Obs. 45° 02' W.

Saturday 31st.

Begins with a fresh S. Easterly breeze & squally under
Short sail. No part light breeze. L. part light Easterly
breeze under all sail. Steaming at 11 A.M. crew employ-
ed in getting up rigging & backstays &c.

Lat. by Obs. 36° 09' N. Long. by Obs. 45° 22' W.

Sunday Sept. 1st.

Begins & Ends pleasant with a light Easterly breeze
under all sail.

Lat. by Obs. 36° 09' N. Long. by Obs. 46° 25' W.

Monday Sept. 2nd 1844.

Begins & Ends pleasant with a light S. E. breeze.
Cruising under all sail at 7 P.M. saw 5 or 6 large
Sperm Whales at 11 A.M. sent boat & Starboard boat
after them at 12 M. Whale trained up. Saw one Seal.

43° 15' N.

Tuesday 3rd.

Begins pleasant with a light, southerly breeze.
Lat 4 P.M. took the whale alongside at 7 finish
cutting in. No part squally & rain. L. part began
boiling head at 11 A.M. Cold down on account of the
rain.

Wednesday 4th.

Begins squally & rain. wind variable at 10 P.M.
Commenced boiling again. L. part cloudy. Cruising
under Short Sail.

Lat. by Obs. 36° 03' N. Long. by Obs. 47° 17' W.

Thursday 5th.

Begins & Ends pleasant with a fine Easterly breeze.
at 11 A.M. part finished boiling. at 8 P.M. saw
Blackfish & W. Boat got out. That made 6 Whales.

Lat. by Obs. 36° 04' N. Long. by Obs. 47° 12' W.
